Travel

Hungary is part of the Schengen zone; most EU citizens can travel without a passport, with their national IDs. Non-EU citizens need a passport to enter Hungary.

Currency and Payment

The currency of Hungary is Hungarian Forint (HUF or Ft). Approximate exchange rate: 1 EUR = 302.50 HUF.

All taxis, all relevant hotels, most cafés and most restaurants accept credit/debit cards (VISA, MasterCard). There are several cash machines (ATMs) near the main locations of the event.

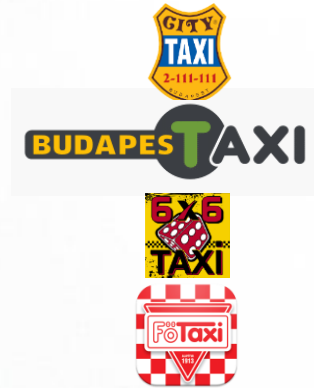

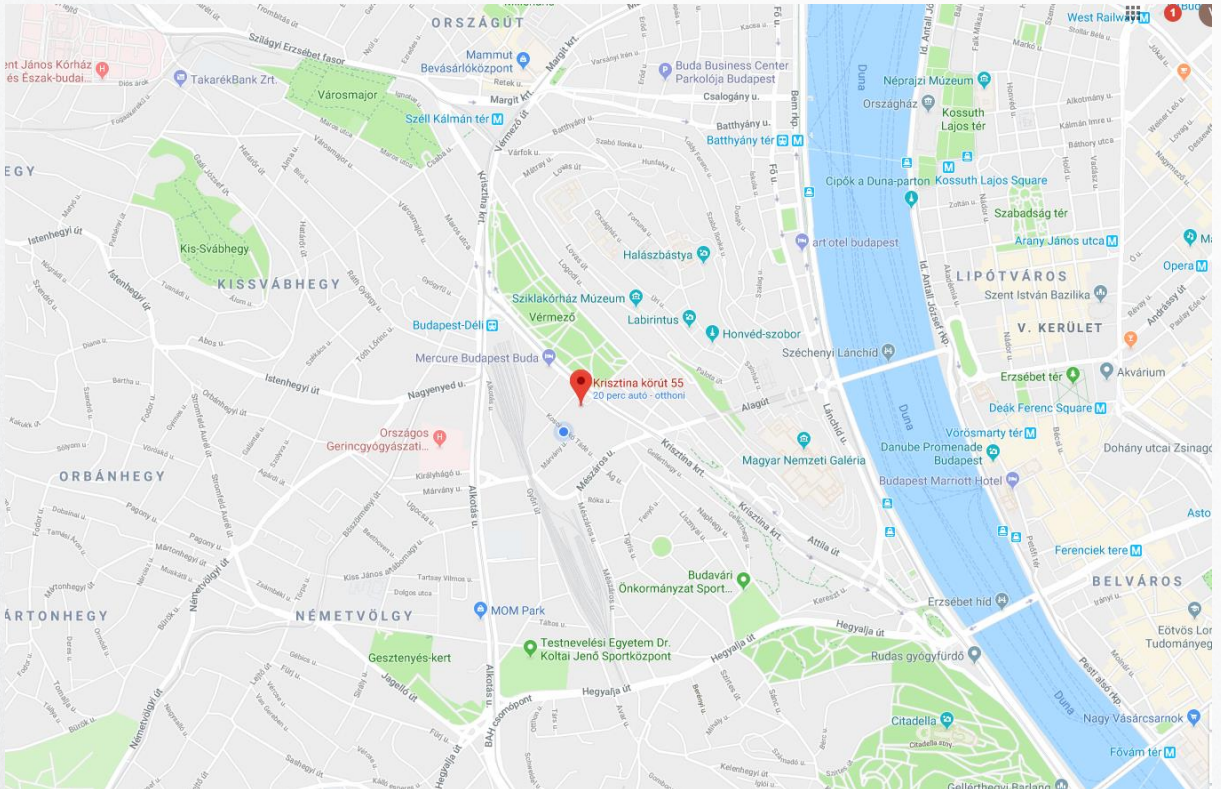

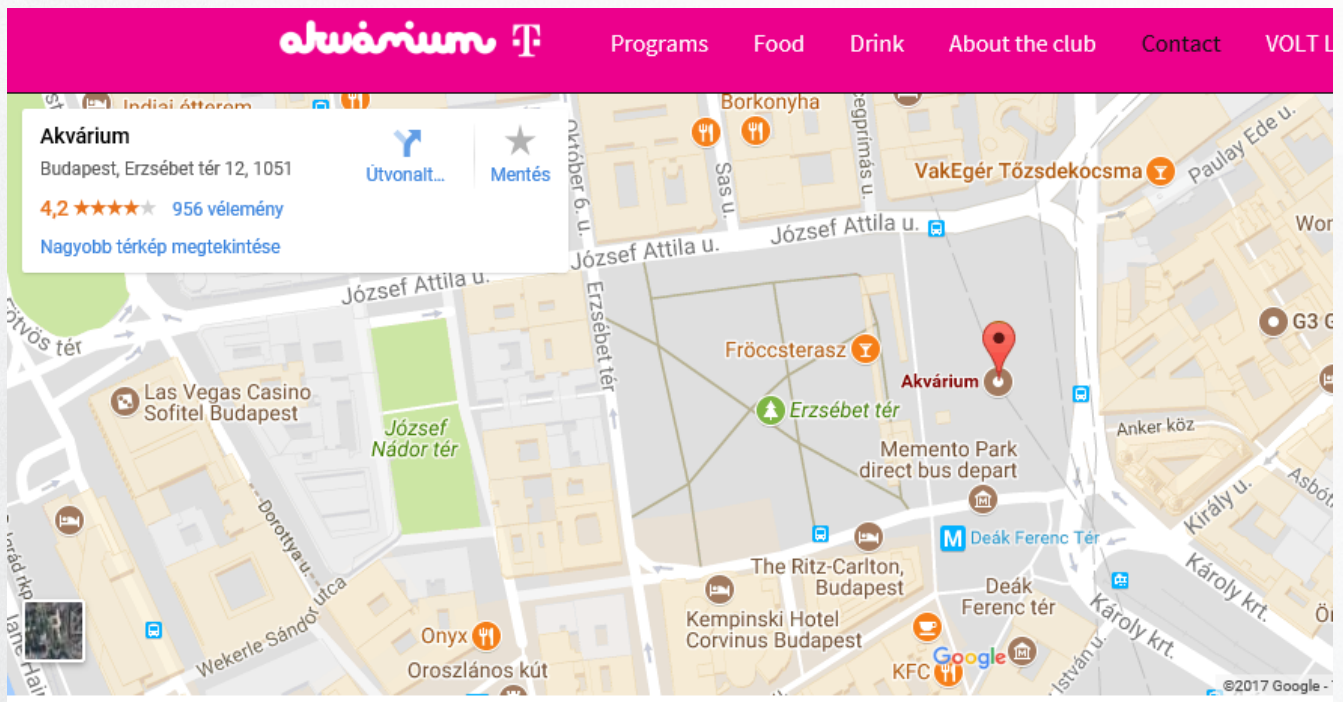
